

Additional information:

Each player must have their own lacrosse stick in which prices start at \$30. A simple youth stick is all that is necessary for this league. It should not be the little “toy” sized sticks that come two to a package and it should not be a girl’s lacrosse stick. The girls rules and equipment are substantially different.

Each boy should wear a cup. We will be playing with a hard regulation lacrosse ball.

After the stick and cup, players can opt to go two different routes in regards to the protective gear, gloves, helmet, arm pads, and shoulder pads: buy your own or use the team gear.

A full set of gear is about \$150. If your child is certain they want to play and you can afford it, go ahead and buy a set. Remember when purchasing that you do not have buy the best gear available. It should fit the child well so their movement and vision are not restricted. Youth rules do not allow much body or stick checking so again top flight gear is not necessary. If you buy a partial set of gear, buy a youth package including gloves, shoulder and arm pads. You can get in on the team pricing at Pal’s Sporting Center. The team order will be sent in by the end of March.

The team will have some equipment. How much equipment we can afford this first year will depend on donations and the results of grants we have applied for. Much of the practices both Thursdays and Sunday will be stick skills and will not require full protective gear. The scrimmage portion on Sundays will be adjusted so that each player will get to put on the gear and play the game. Because of the need to share equipment, the equipment fee will only be \$25 for those who have less than a full set of protective gear. Please indicate on your application form if you will be purchasing a full or partial set of gear.
